SCENE *insiders* is a unique 3 day script development training programme offering a line-up of workshops, screenings, masterclasses and a fantastic opportunity to network with some of Europe's most talented new filmmakers.

Workshops

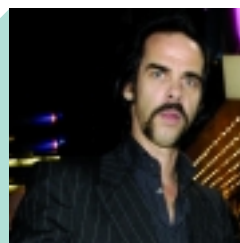
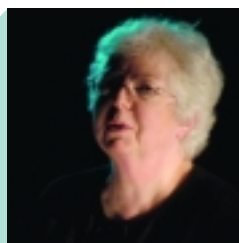
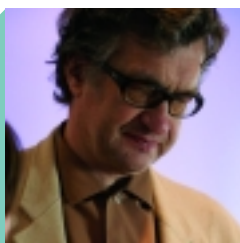
The core of the programme is a series of in-depth workshops exploring the different skills required for expert script development from screenplay analysis to pitching projects. SCENE *insiders* workshops provide essential training for film professionals who want to refine the way they work with screenwriters.

Masterclasses

Access to The Script Factory's Festival Masterclasses gives a chance to explore the art of creative filmmaking and hone in on some of the most interesting voices in the business. Previous SCENE *insiders* masterclasses have been given by Wim Wenders, Thelma Schoonmaker, Nick Cave, Bent Hamer and Alexander Payne amongst many others.

Network

SCENE *insiders* offers exceptional opportunities to network and establish creative relationships with some of Europe's most talented new filmmakers. After the programme, everyone involved in SCENE *insiders* has access to The Network – an online site designed to help sustain relationships already established and to help meet potential new collaborators from across Europe.



WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Schedule

SCENE *insiders* will take place over 3 days at one of three international Film Festivals during 2006/07.

Participants

Suitable for producers, directors, writers, sales agents, distributors, script consultants, script editors, script developers, script readers, marketing executives or film educators.

Participants must be from a country participating in the MEDIA programme (this includes all European Union and European Economic Area member states).

SCENE *insiders* will be conducted in English, so knowledge of the English language is essential.

25 participants will be invited to each of the three programmes.

Fee

Cost per participant attending SCENE *insiders* Edinburgh is £210 (plus UK VAT at £36.75).

Cost per participant attending SCENE *insiders* Warsaw & Gothenburg is £210 (No VAT payable).

Fees cover the cost of 6 workshop sessions, 2 screenings, 2 masterclasses, accreditation to your chosen festival and lunches.

Bursaries

There are 3 full bursaries available per programme to cover the cost of travel, accommodation and fees which are available to participants from countries that have recently joined the European Union. Selected additional bursaries are available to cover accommodation.

Accommodation

Accommodation will be available for participants at discounted rates and will be booked by the programme organisers.

First Deadline for Application

Friday 23 June 2006

Selection Procedure

Applicants will be chosen on the basis of professional motivation and experience and selected by representatives of The Script Factory and Festival Partners.

Confirmation of receipt of application will be issued by email and places will be allocated at least 6 weeks in advance of each programme.
